


## 101 and Out!

You need: 1-6 die

1 sheet of paper per person

This is a game for two or more players. Each player makes a recording sheet as shown.



## **Directions:**

- 1. Take turns rolling the die.
- 2. On each turn, all players write the number in either the tens column or ones column of their recording sheet. Once a number is recorded, it cannot be changed.
- 3. After rolling six numbers, fill in any blank spaces in the ones column with 0s and add.

The player with the sum closest to 100 without going over is the winner.
